PARKING 2018

Due to work by the Level Crossing Removal Authority (LCRA), parking adjacent to the theatre is restricted. The Rosanna railway car parks will be closed for most of 2018. The car park in front of the old Council office in Turnham Ave. is no longer a public car park.

Parking can be found at:

- The car park off Douglas Street behind the Library. The yellow marked bays (LCRA restricted parking) are available to Theatre patrons attending a performance.
- Street parking on Turnham Avenue and Beetham Parade.
- Temporary car parking bays on Elsmere Parade north side of Lower Plenty Road.

We recommend you allow extra time to find parking and to arrive at the Theatre no later than 7.45 pm for an evening performance and by 1.45 pm for a matinee performance.


